CURRENT QUESTIONS

Q Can the water in the moorage really carry an electric shock?

A Yes. It's rare, but faulty wiring on a boat or dock can leak electricity into the surrounding water, and that creates a risk known as Electric Shock Drowning (ESD). Even a small current can lock up a swimmer's muscles and make it impossible to reach safety. Fresh water conducts poorly, so the current takes the easier path: through swimmers, not the water around them.

Never swim near docks where boats are plugged into shore power. And if someone's ever in trouble in the water, don't jump in after them. Cut the power first, then throw them a flotation device. We keep electric current testers in the maintenance shed for anyone who wants to borrow one and check their own slip. With family and guests around all summer, it's a small step worth taking.
